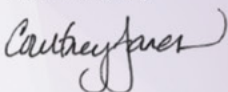
This report reflects the impact of those investments—demonstrating measurable improvements in mental health, stronger family connections, and expanded access to critical services.

# OUR STORY & IMPACT

Founded in 2012, Infinite Hero Foundation was created with a clear purpose: to invest in innovative solutions that improve recovery outcomes for military, veterans and military family members. Inspired by the experiences of service members returning home with complex physical and invisible wounds, our work is grounded in a belief that recovery must evolve—and that better solutions must be advanced.

# STRATEGIC INVESTMENT SPOTLIGHT

2025

## BASTION COMMUNITY OF RESILIENCE



Infinite Hero invested in Bastion Community of Resilience to expand access to clinically driven mental health programs that improve long-term outcomes for veterans. Through an 8-week, clinically led wellness intensive and ongoing community model, the program addresses isolation and sustained recovery—advancing a scalable approach to mental health care aligned with our focus on measurable, long-term impact.

### IMPACT

#### PARTICIPANTS

- 60 Veterans served

#### CLINICAL IMPROVEMENTS

- 66%+ reduction in psychological distress
- 75%+ reduction in depression
- 50-60% reduction in anxiety and stress
- Up to 100% reduction in PTSD symptoms

#### ENGAGEMENT & CONNECTION

- 100% reported improved mental health
- 87% reported increased connection and belonging

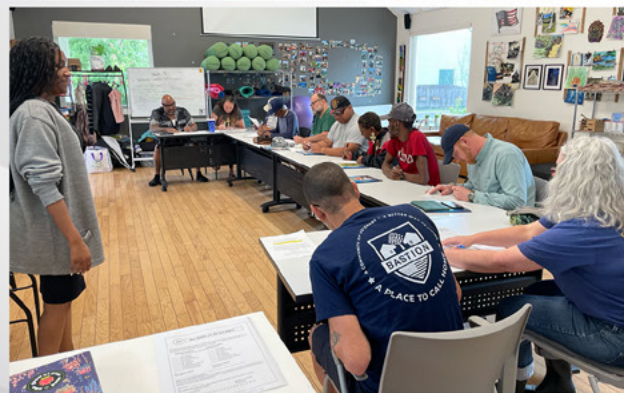
Outcomes have improved across cohorts, with participants remaining engaged through alumni programming and peer mentorship—extending impact over time.

## CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL LOS ANGELES



Infinite Hero partnered with Children's Hospital Los Angeles to advance a novel, non-distressing treatment approach for combat-related PTSD—expanding access to care for veterans who may otherwise avoid traditional therapies. By integrating real-time brain imaging with treatment delivery, this model reduces barriers to care while improving engagement and long-term treatment adoption.

### IMPACT

107 combat veterans served, including 59 diagnosed with PTSD

**\$100,000**

#### **HIGH ENGAGEMENT AND TREATMENT ACCEPTANCE:**

- 79.6% completion rate, exceeding typical retention for PTSD treatment
- 91% reported the treatment as non-distressing
- 90.7% would recommend the program to other veterans

#### **REDUCED BARRIERS TO MENTAL HEALTH CARE:**

- 55.8% reported reduced likelihood of avoiding treatment
- 85.1% accepted referrals for further care (excluding those already in treatment)
- 62% engaged in mental health care within six months, up from 33.2% at baseline

This intervention served as a critical entry point for veterans historically resistant to treatment by demonstrating that improving accessibility and experience can significantly increase engagement in long-term care.

## FORGE

### OVERWATCH PROJECT +

Infinite Hero supported FORGE to expand peer-based suicide prevention training that equips service members and veterans to recognize risk and intervene during critical transition periods. This model demonstrates how peer-led, community-driven approaches can extend impact beyond direct participants—creating scalable solutions to reduce suicide risk.

### IMPACT

2,258 service members trained at critical transition points

#### EXPANDED REACH THROUGH PEER-TO-PEER IMPACT:

- 63% shared training with others
- Average of 4.46 additional people reached
- 6,344 additional individuals impacted

#### DEMONSTRATED BEHAVIOR CHANGE:

- Increased confidence in intervening
- Increased proactive safety planning
- Significant improvements across knowledge, intent, and action

This program extends beyond direct participants by driving adoption across units, communities, and multiple states.

## FRONTLINE FOCUS FOUNDATION



Infinite Hero invested in Frontline Focus Foundation to expand access to trauma-informed, holistic wellness programs supporting veterans and families navigating PTSD, TBI, and suicidal ideation. By combining meditation training with psychedelic-assisted therapy and structured integration, the program represents an emerging, comprehensive model for long-term healing.

### IMPACT

64 veterans and family members served

**\$100,000**

### DEMONSTRATED IMPROVEMENTS:

- 100% program completion rate
- 100% reported reduction in suicidal ideation
- 51 participants reduced unnecessary pharmaceutical use under guidance

Participants reported meaningful improvements in emotional regulation, resilience, and overall quality of life with peer support networks continuing beyond the program.

*"Through this program, I experienced a complete reduction in suicidal ideation and felt present with my family for the first time in years. It gave me my life back."*

## PROJECT SANCTUARY



Infinite Hero partnered with Project Sanctuary to develop and implement a standardized teen curriculum that strengthens family-centered recovery. By aligning youth and adult programming, this model reinforces communication, resilience, and long-term well-being—highlighting the critical role of family support in recovery.

### IMPACT

#### PROGRAM DEVELOPMENT

- First standardized teen curriculum implemented across all retreats
- Alignment between youth and adult programming

#### PARTICIPANT IMPACT

- Improved communication, coping, and self-expression
- High engagement and participant satisfaction
- Strong peer connection among youth participants

#### LONG-TERM IMPACT

- Establishes a scalable, repeatable model for future retreats
- Strengthens the effectiveness of family-based recovery programs

This investment strengthens a scalable model that improves outcomes across generations—reinforcing the critical role families play in long-term recovery and well-being.

## THE WISDOM DOJO



Infinite Hero supported The Wisdom Dojo to expand access to structured meditation training and peer-led programming that supports mental health and long-term recovery. By creating pathways for veterans to become instructors, the model not only improves individual outcomes but builds leadership, community, and economic opportunity.

### IMPACT

#### PARTICIPATION & GROWTH

- 211 veterans served across programs
  - 121 Fundamentals Training (+33% YoY)
  - 33 Advanced Training (+38% YoY)
  - 41 Retreat Participants (+17% YoY)
  - 17 Instructor Training (+143% YoY)

#### PEER-LED IMPACT

- 95% program completion rate

#### ENGAGEMENT

- 31 veteran instructors trained
- Veterans deliver 86% of Phase 1 programming

#### ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY

- \$81,415 earned by veteran instructors

## WORLDMAKER RESILIENCE INSTITUTE



Infinite Hero invested in Worldmaker Resilience Institute to scale a technology-enabled resilience training program that supports sustained behavior change across veterans and their families. By combining digital tools, in-person training, and family-centered resources, this model expands access while strengthening long-term outcomes.

### IMPACT

**\$50,000**

Investment

#### REACH

- 604 individuals and families served
  - 100 training participants
  - 204 app users
  - 200 families supported through THRIVE Kits

#### ENGAGEMENT & ADOPTION

- 62% app adoption rate
- 86% user engagement
- Nearly half of users engage weekly
- 5,192 videos watched
- 39,608 minutes of engagement

#### RESILIENCE & WELL-BEING OUTCOMES

- 90%+ improved ability to manage stress
- 94% reported stronger relationships
- 100% reported increased hope

This program is now being applied across military units, first-responder environments, and family settings—expanding its reach well beyond the initial delivery.

## RECOVERY IS NOT ONE-SIZE-FITS-ALL—AND TRADITIONAL APPROACHES ALONE ARE NOT ENOUGH.

Veterans face complex mental, physical, and personal challenges that require solutions that meet them where they are.

The programs we support are changing what recovery looks like in practice—reaching veterans who previously avoided care, strengthening family systems, and creating new pathways for long-term healing.

## THIS IS WHAT THAT LOOKS LIKE:

- Veterans engaging in care who once stayed on the sidelines
- Families rebuilding connection, stability, and resilience
- New approaches expanding how recovery is understood and delivered

## THIS IS THE IMPACT OF THAT WORK:

- Addressing the full spectrum of recovery
- Creating meaningful, sustained change
- Delivering results that extend beyond individual participants

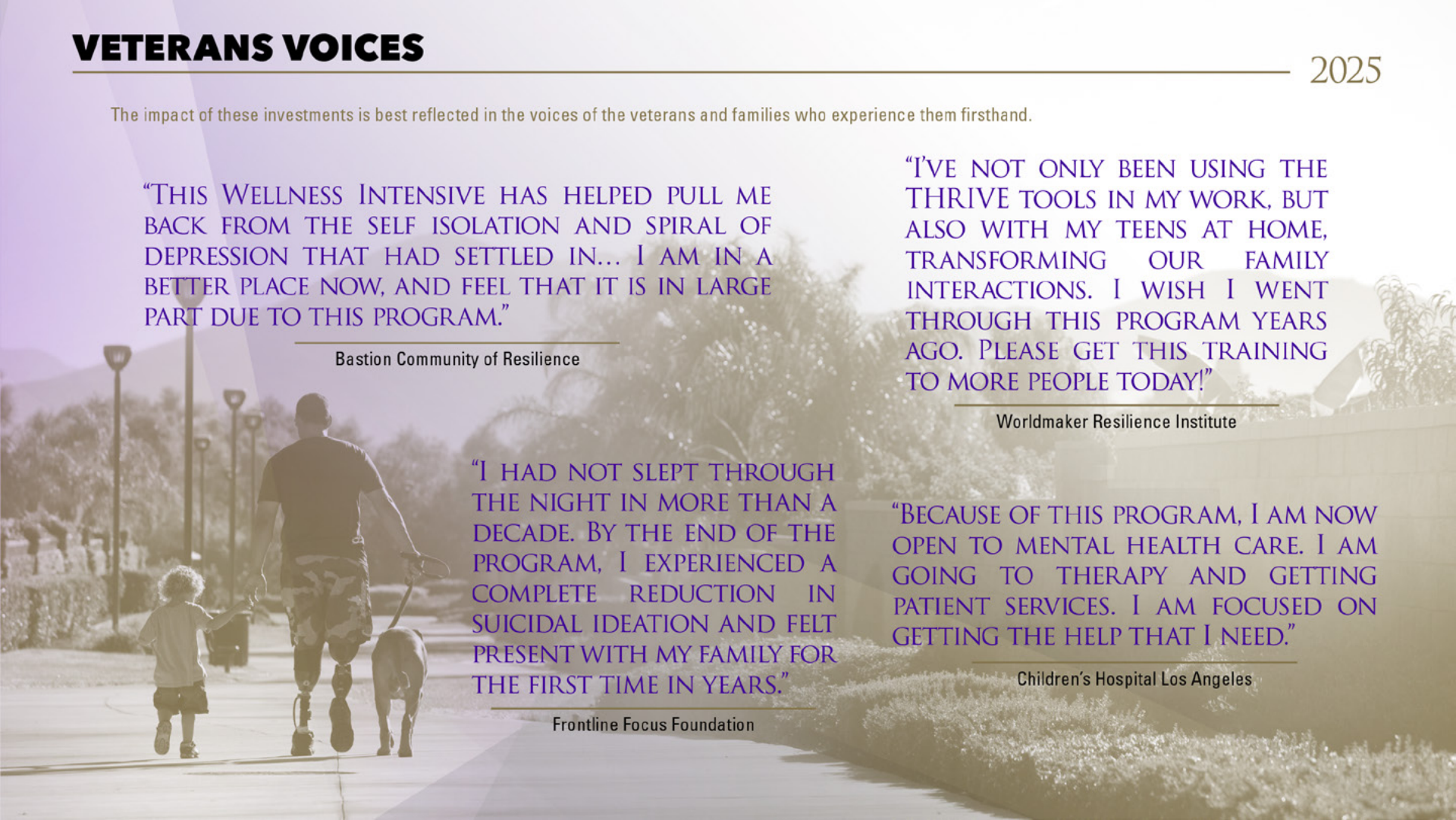
